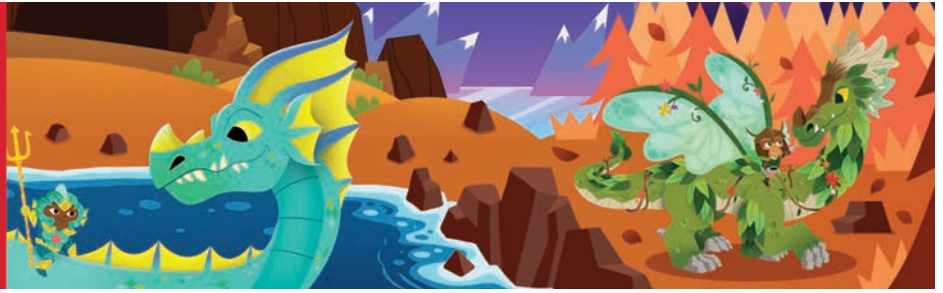
## ACTIVITIES FOR HOME

## **FIRE-BREATHING PAPER ROLL DRAGON**

### **WHAT YOU'LL NEED:**

- Safety scissors
- Paper roll
- Tissue paper
- Non-toxic glue
- Poof balls
- Googly eyes
- Paint brush
- Non-toxic paint

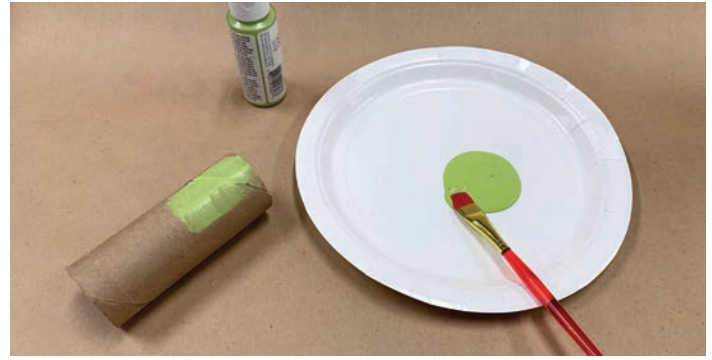


**CAUTION:** The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.





1. Cut the paper roll in half.



2. Paint the paper roll green.



3. Decorate the painted paper roll with pom-poms and googly eyes.



4. Use yellow, orange, and red tissue paper.



5. Cut 6 x 7 inch rectangles from each color. Then, cut 1/2 inch-wide strips into each of the rectangles, but DON'T cut them off.



6. Glue all 3 sheets of tissue paper together at the top.



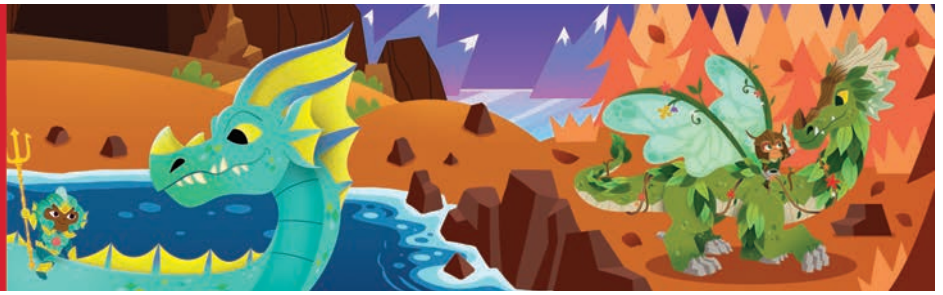
7. Wrap the 3 glued layers of tissue paper into a circle and glue it at the top.



8. Glue the tissue paper into the inside of the painted and decorated paper roll.

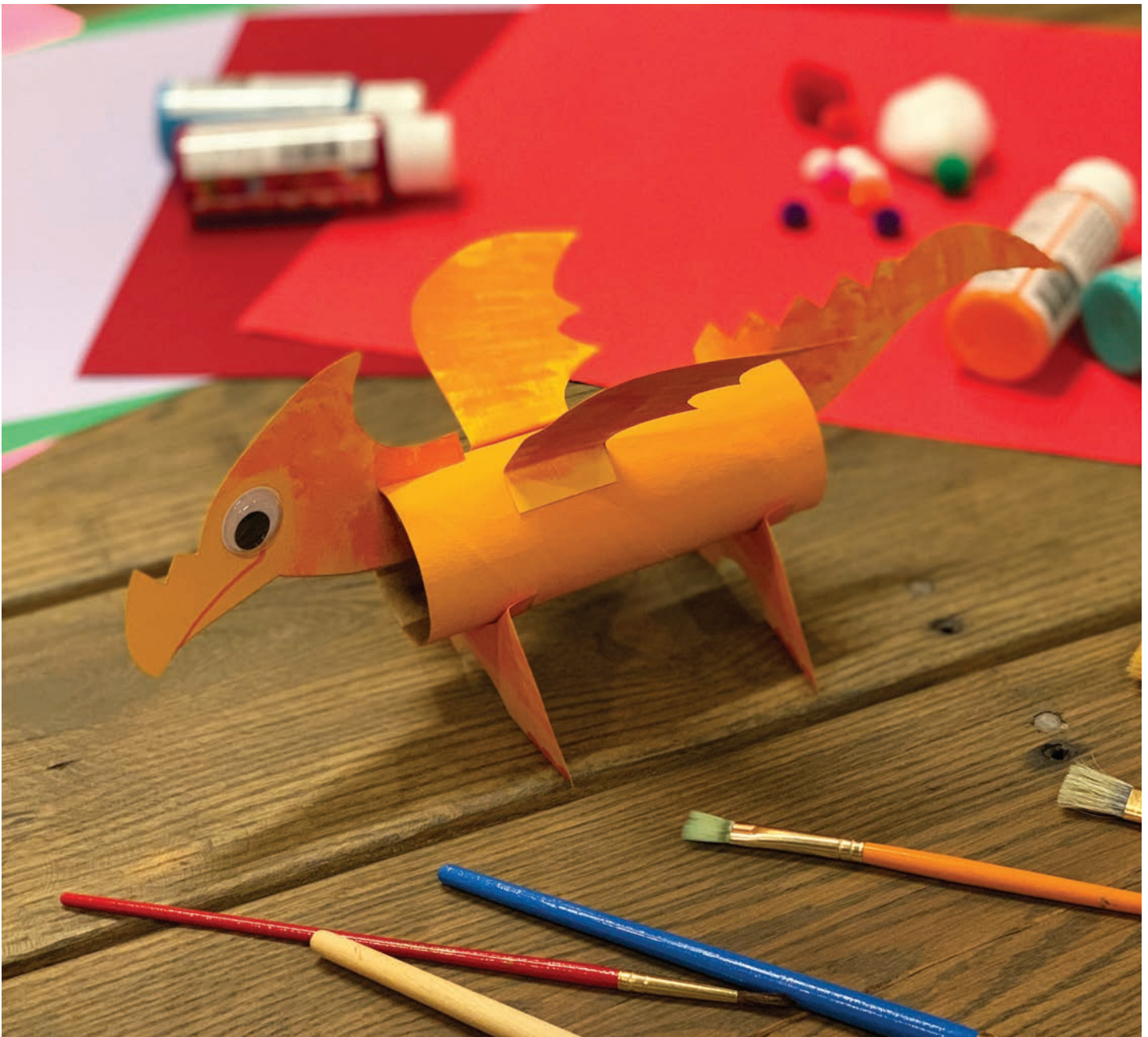
# PAPER CRAFT DRAGON

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Construction paper
- Safety scissors
- Non-toxic glue
- Googly eyes
- Non-toxic paint
- Paint brush
- Non-toxic markers
- Dragon template
- Paper roll
- Pencil
- Ruler



**CAUTION:** The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.





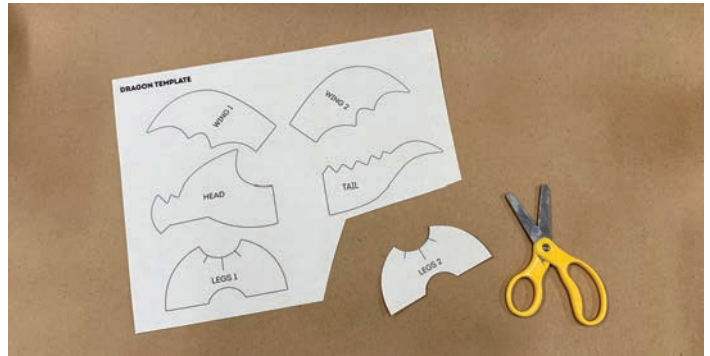
1. Cut the paper roll in half.



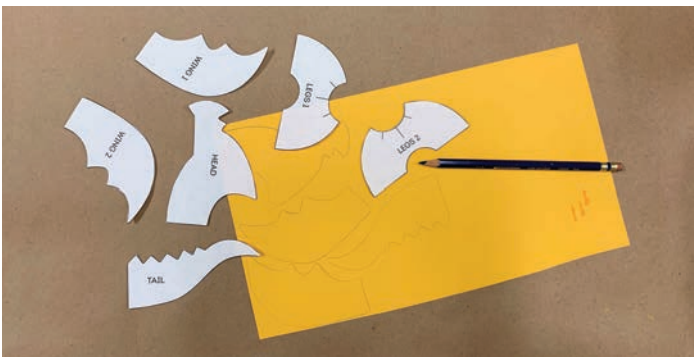
2. Paint the paper roll orange.



3. Print out the dragon template provided with the activities for home (page 7).



4. Cut out each piece on the template.



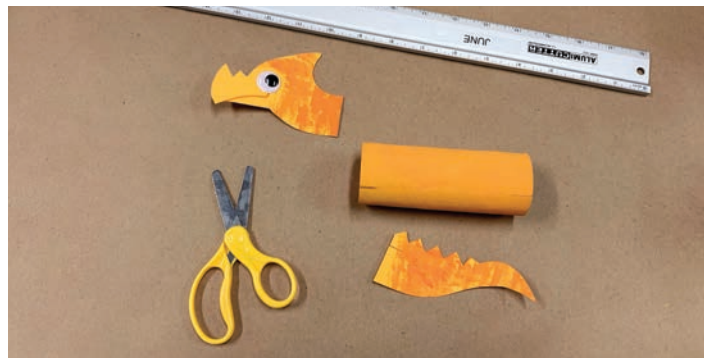
5. Trace each piece onto construction paper. Then, cut out the traced construction paper pieces.



6. Decorate the head with googly eyes and draw on a mouth. Draw toes on the legs.



7. Paint the traced template pieces to create a scale-like texture.



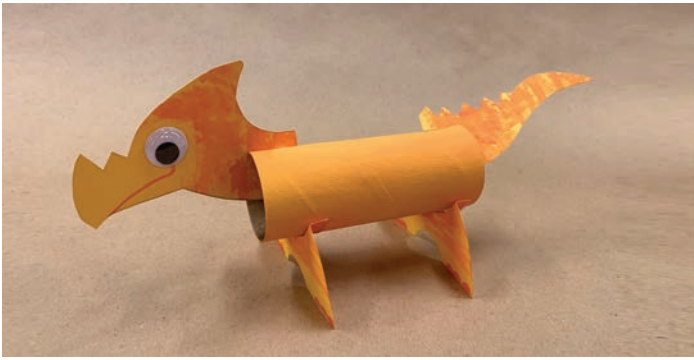
8. Cut 1/2-inch slots into the head, the tail, and the back and front of the paper roll.



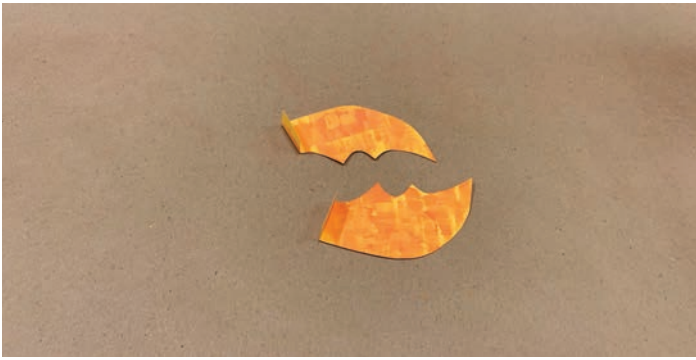
9. Insert the head and tail pieces into their 1/2-inch slots.



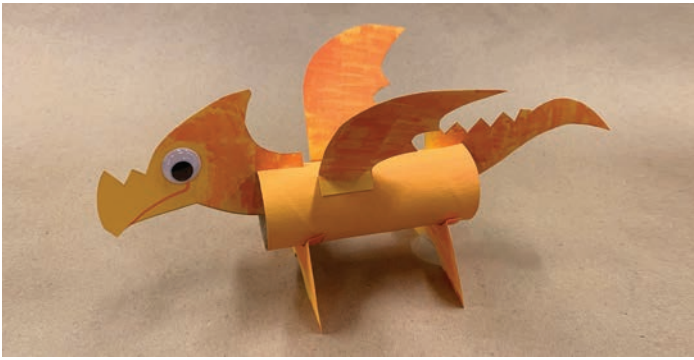
10. Cut in the tabs (as shown in the template) and bend them back.



11. Glue the legs on the paper roll body.

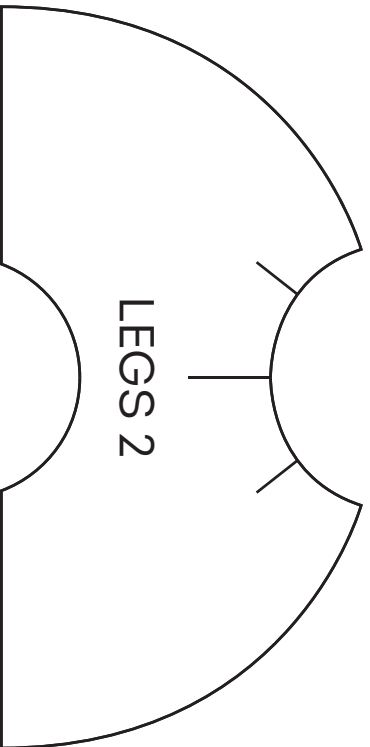
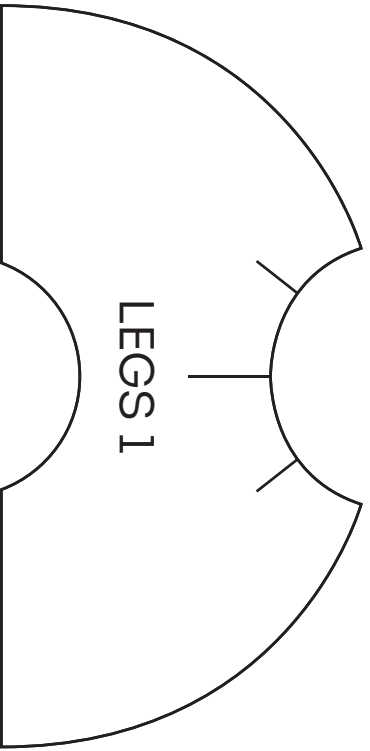
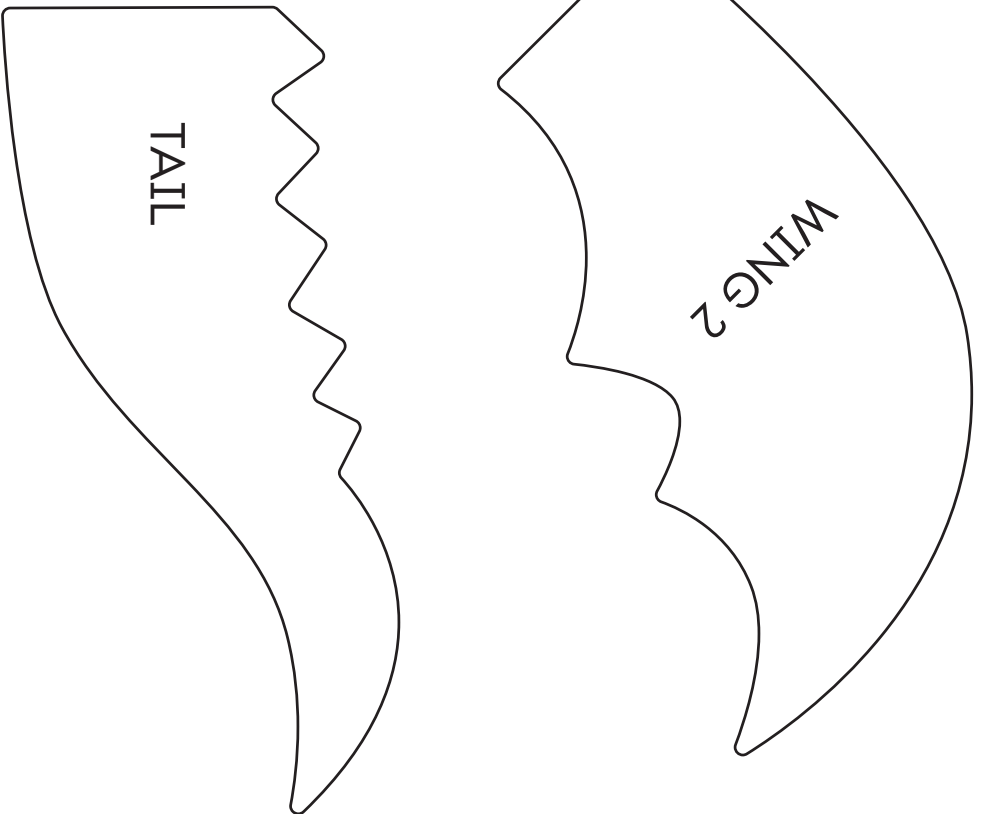
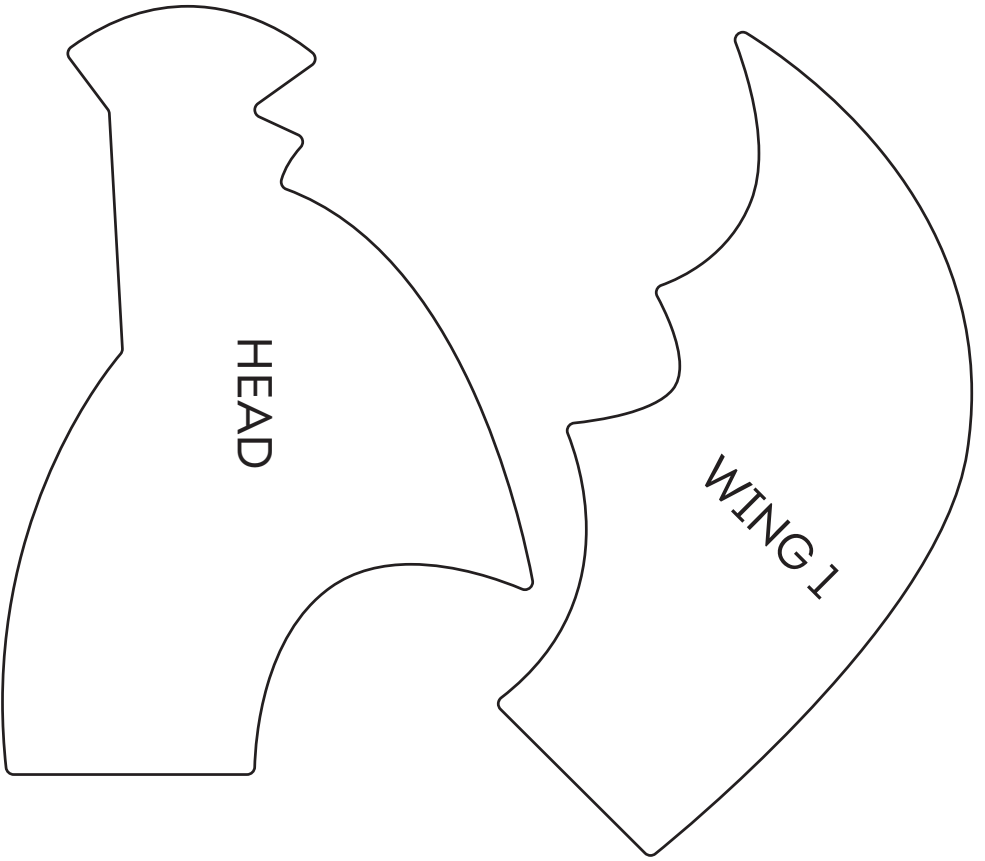


12. Bend back the tabs on the wings.



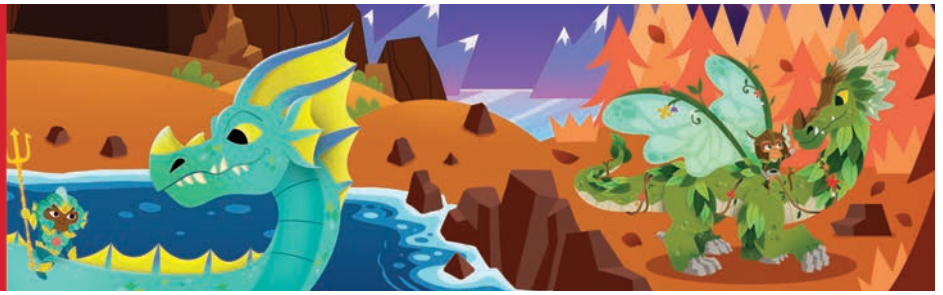
13. Glue the wings to the top of the paper roll body.

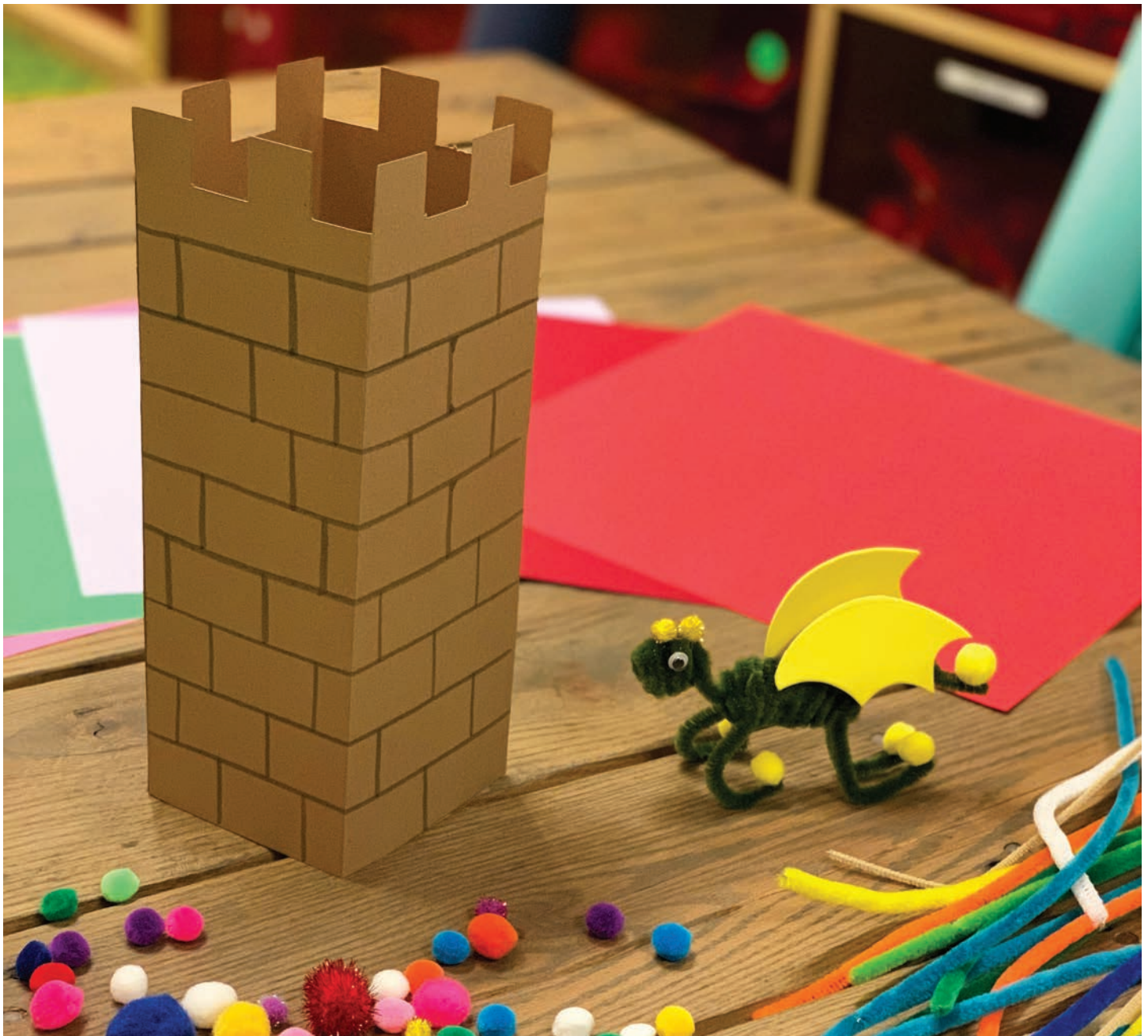
# DRAGON TOWER

## WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

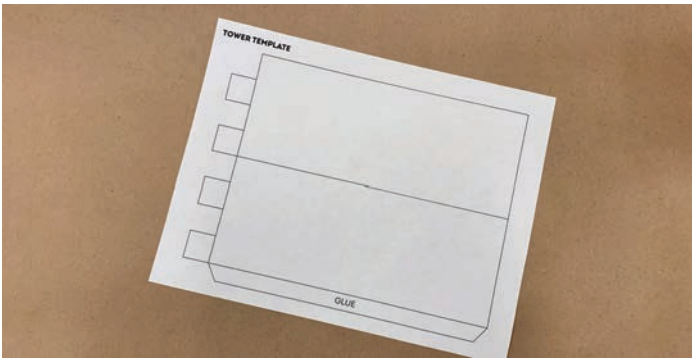
- Construction paper
- Safety scissors
- Non-toxic glue
- Pipe cleaners
- Googly eyes
- Foam sheets
- Poof balls
- Non-toxic markers
- Tower template
- Wide craft stick
- Pencil



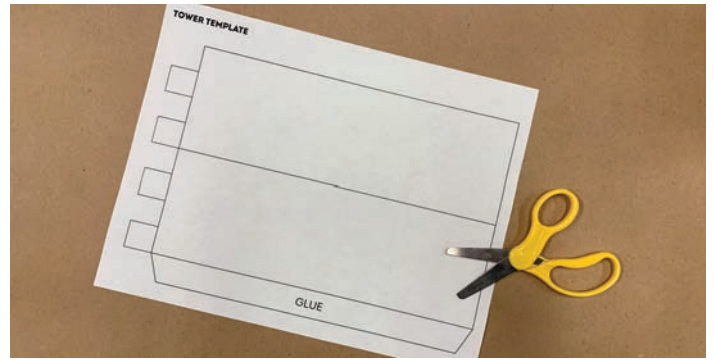

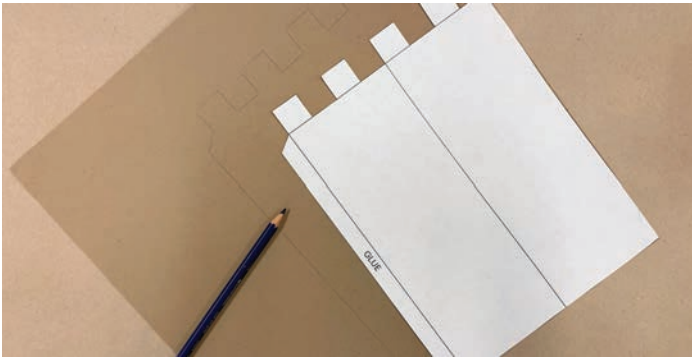




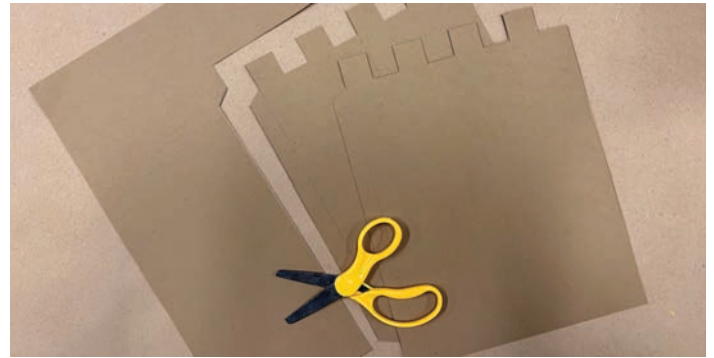
1. Print the tower template provided with the activities for home (page 11).



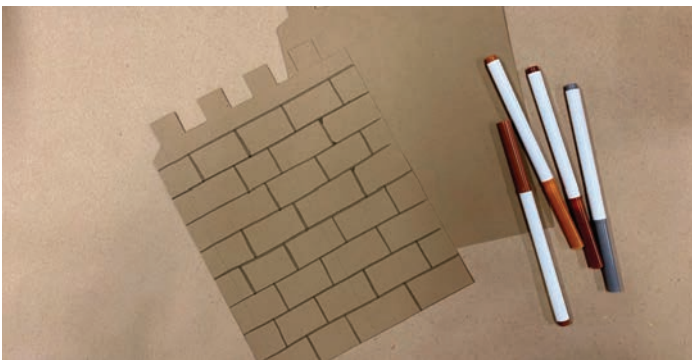
2. Cut out the template.



3. Trace the template on two sheets of brown construction paper.



4. Cut out the traced shapes.



5. Draw on bricks with markers.



6. Fold the construction paper at the specified location as shown in the template.



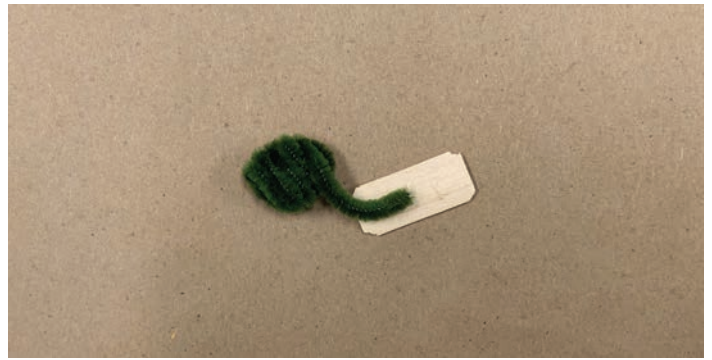
7. Glue the two pieces of construction paper at the glue line shown on the template. You are done with the first part of this craft.



8. Choose any color of pipe cleaner, and create a small circle.



9. Wrap the remaining length of the pipe cleaner over the circle, but leave a little for the neck.



10. Take a wide craft stick and cut it to a length of 1 1/2 inches, and align it with the neck.



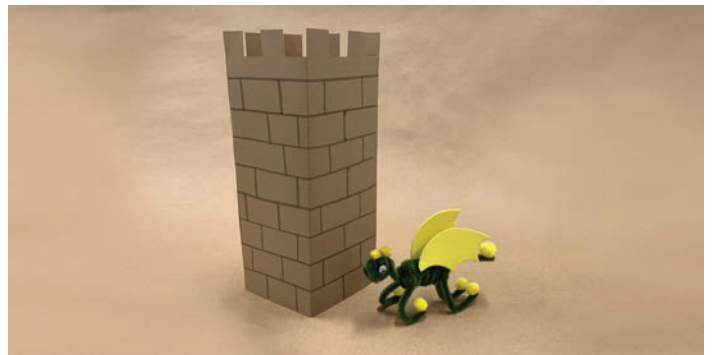
11. Take up to 3 new pipe cleaners, and wrap them around the craft stick to connect the neck to the body. Wrap the pipe cleaners around the craft stick until it is covered and leave a little bit of excess for the tail.



12. Fold one pipe cleaner into 4 sections and cut it into small pieces to create legs. Glue them to the body.

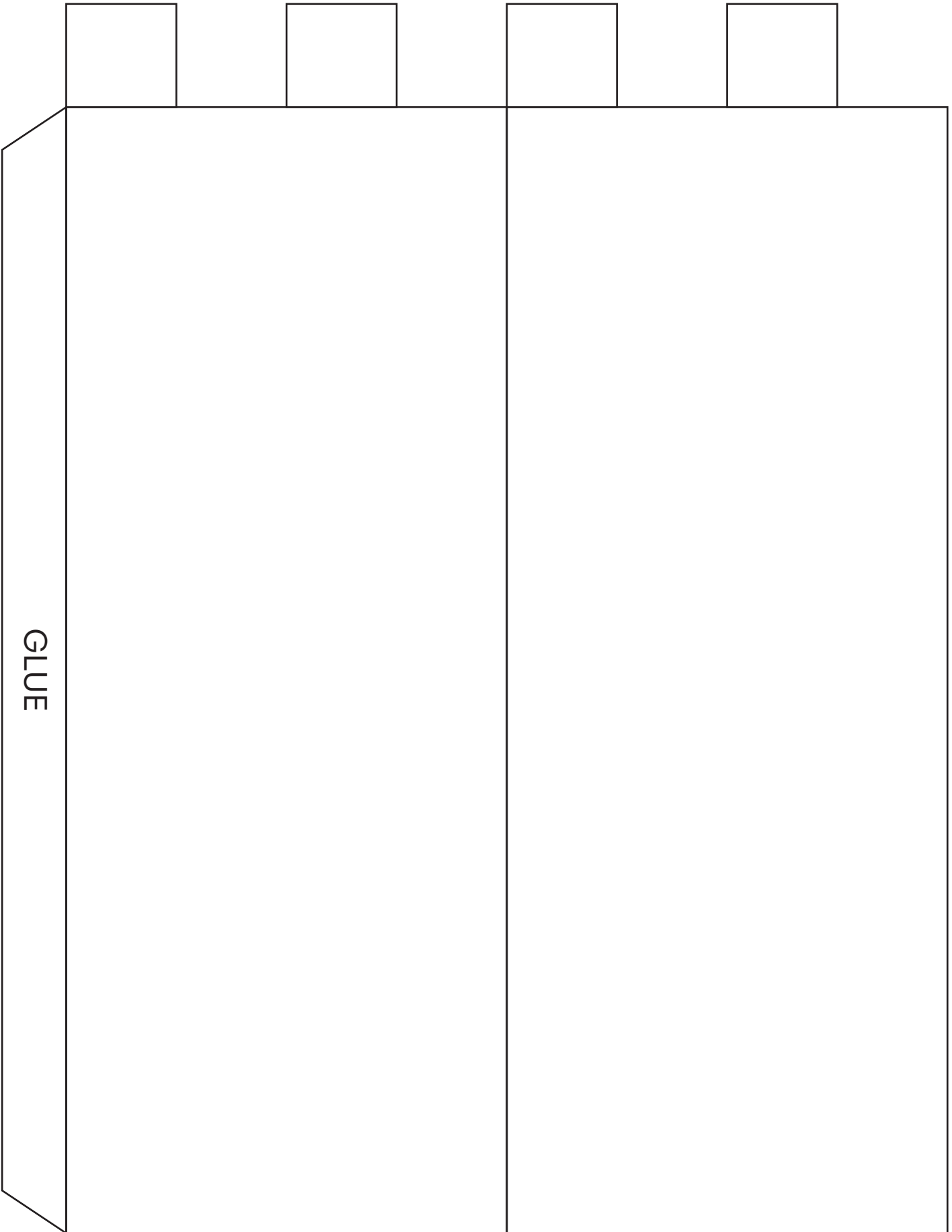


13. Decorate the body with googly eyes, foam sheet wings, and poof balls.



14. Let your pipe cleaner dragon defend your tower!
