VOLCANO

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Pencil
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Non-toxic craft glue
- Red, yellow, green and orange tissue paper

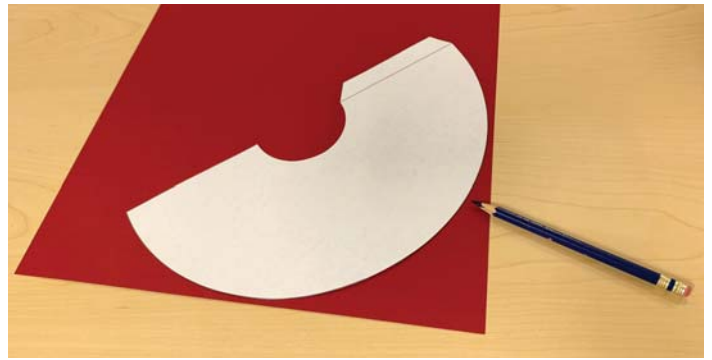


CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.





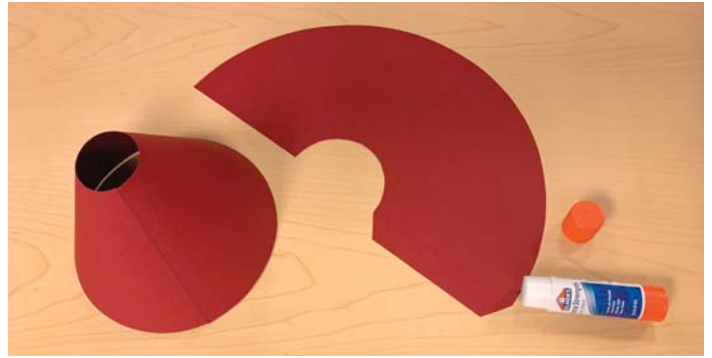
1. Print out the template for the volcano and cut out the shape.



2. Place the volcano template on construction paper in the color of your choice and trace around it.



3. After you finish tracing the shape, cut it out of the construction paper.



4. Glue the flap to create the volcano shape.



5. Take yellow, orange, and red tissue paper, cut them into strips, and crinkle up the paper.



6. Insert the strips of tissue paper into the opening of the volcano.



7. Trace the outline of a round object on construction paper that is slightly larger than the volcano. Then cut it out.



8. Place and glue your volcano on the round base and roll green tissue paper to create small balls to glue around the base of the volcano to create a forest.

TRACKS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Cardboard
- Scissors
- 1-3 Sponges
- Non-toxic paint
- Non-toxic glue
- Non-toxic marker
- Disposable plate

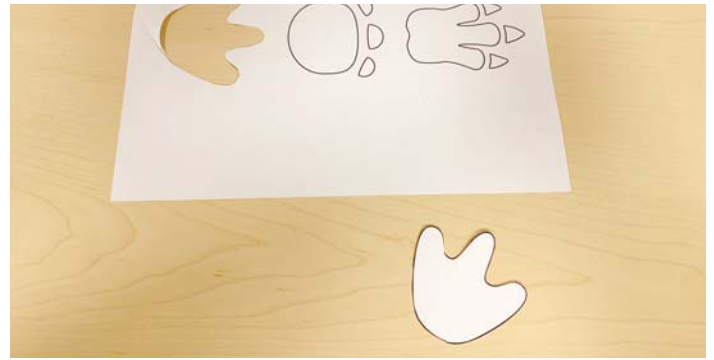


CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.





1. Print out the dinosaur track template.



2. Cut out the dinosaur tracks.



3. Trace the shapes of the dinosaur tracks onto a sponge.



4. Cut out the dinosaur track shape.



5. Cut out a rectangular shape of cardboard to fit the dinosaur track sponge.



6. Glue the sponge onto the cardboard rectangle.



7. Pour some non-toxic paint onto a disposable plate and dip the sponge in the paint. Stamp it onto any type of blank paper.

DIORAMA

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Medium-sized shoebox
- Construction paper
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Non-toxic craft glue
- Non-toxic paint
- Tape



CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.





1. Use an empty shoebox as the base of the diorama.



2. Cut a piece of cardboard to fit inside of the box, as shown in the picture.



3. Glue the cardboard to the lid and side of the box to create a sturdy base.



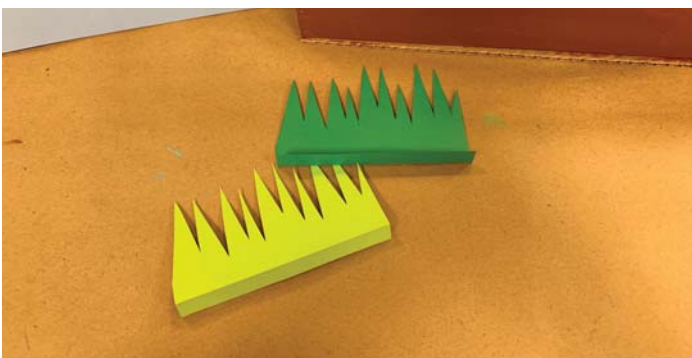
4. Paint the outside of the box brown. Paint the inside blue and green.



5. Cut the mountain shapes out of construction paper to create a background elements.



6. Glue or tape the mountain shapes onto the sky area to create a backdrop for the diorama.



7. Cut the grass and trees out of construction paper and create a fold at the bottom of each shape.



8. Glue them to the grass area of the shoebox to create a pop-up effect.
